

12. PATIENT HAS THE RIGHT...

When asked to participate in research projects;
To be informed of the methods, expected benefits, potential risks, description of alternative services and purposes of the experiments, research and projects that can be done with him and that will require a written authorization to take part in them. A refuse it without compromising their access to health services

13. PATIENT HAS THE RIGHT...

A privacy and confidentiality with everything related to him under current legislation, including the following:
Be interviewed and examined in an appropriate area.

- That consultation and discussion of your case will be treated with confidentiality.
- Medical records, procedures, treatments, and medical diagnostics
- Access to your medical record information according to the laws within a reasonable time.

DUTIES OF PATIENTS

1. THE PATIENT HAS THE DUTY...

To provide complete information on their health status (prior treatments, medications used, previous hospitalizations, etc.)

2. THE PATIENT HAS THE DUTY...

To follow the treatment plan prescribed by the physician and other health professionals responsible for their care (using drugs, keeping appointments, etc.).

3. THE PATIENT HAS THE DUTY...

To submit, at the time of admission cards health plans and / or make a payment plan, meet within a reasonable time financial

obligations related to the health services received.

4. THE PATIENT HAS THE DUTY...

Take responsibility for your actions and their consequences, among others, does not meet the rules and regulations, if he refuses treatment, does not meet the medical instructions ...

5. THE PATIENT HAS THE DUTY...

being of all, including these:

- NO SMOKING
- NOT ask their relatives to bring food
Because they can interfere with treatment and recovery.
- HELP
To keep the facility clean and tidy.
- TO RESPECT AND CONSIDER
The other patients and staff, as well as the rights and property of these and comply with the disciplinary rules of the Institute.

6. The patient has the duty ...
To be accompanied on the day of surgery with a responsible adult accompany the same home as soon be discharged.

Bill of Rights and Duties of Patients



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RIGHT OF PATIENTS

1. PATIENT HAS THE RIGHT...

To receive medical care on an outpatient basis, responding to requests and needs for treatment and his condition warrants service within available resources, and the philosophy, mission, regulations and laws.

2. PATIENT HAS THE RIGHT...

A respectful care for their human dignity regardless of race, color, creed or religious beliefs, sex, political beliefs, national origin, socioeconomic status, source of payment, disability and / or mental including:

(1) Consideration of psychosocial, spiritual and cultural characteristics of the person, which can affect the perception of their condition.

2. PATIENT HAS THE RIGHT...

To assist doctors in charge of their treatment to make decisions about your health care, including:

- (1) accept or refuse medical care and treatment for your health condition, according to what the law allows.
- (2) participate in all aspects of their care
- (3) participate in the consideration of ethical issues arising in health care;
- (4) be informed of the medical consequences of their decisions about their health
- (5) voluntarily make advance directives about their decisions about your health care of special situations;
- (6) appoint a person to exercise rights on their behalf and make decisions about treatments and
- (7) procedures necessary in situations where he cannot do to be medically

- or legally incapacitated and unable to communicate, or is a minor;
- (8) that the Institute will provide guidance on the right to develop advance directives;
 - (9) receive services and medical treatment, although it has not made advance directives;
 - (10) that the blade orientation advance directives are kept in the medical record. If patient transfer from the Institute to a hospital, the hospital will send copies.

3. PATIENT HAS THE RIGHT...

In the immediate relatives to be informed, and if you want to participate in the resolution of conflict situations, decisions about care.

4. PATIENT HAS THE RIGHT...

To receive information on admission and / or pre-admission on the following:

- The rights and duties of patients.
- The Rules and Regulations of the Institute to be met during your stay.
- The mechanisms and procedures for communicating with the Administration to submit claims, complaints, suggestions about the services and receive answers to them.
- The right to exercise self-determination to receive or refuse medical treatment through the formulation of advance directives.
- A family member or a representative selected by the patient is notified promptly of your admission to the Institute.
- The privacy and accessibility to medical records standards

5. PATIENT HAS THE RIGHT...

To request a copy of your medical record for as long as I have is Treated at the Institute and / or up to 5 years from the last entry and / or visit. After This term it May dispose of medical records without patient authorization. The Institute will keep those documents specified by law for an additional 5 years.

6. PATIENT HAS THE RIGHT...

The name of the health professionals in charge of your care.

7. PATIENT HAS THE RIGHT...

At that practices and environment of the Institute are to Their Appropriate health and safety staff.

8. PATIENT HAS THE RIGHT...

To Receive detailed information on the full bill for medical services received.

9. PATIENT HAS THE RIGHT...

Guidance on health care Should follow eleven discharged.

10. PATIENT HAS THE RIGHT...

To receive an informed written for treatments, procedures, surgeries, anesthesia and other procedures conducted at the Institute consent information.

To receive complete and continued information, verbal and / or written about your diagnosis, treatment, risk and prognosis in understandable language that allows you to make decisions and select among the alternatives that the doctor offers.
